Working closely with the Operational Leads across Group the post holder will be responsible for developing technical installation solutions for our mobile and modular facilities from pre-contract through to practical completion. The role extends to covering our solutions across our focus geographies in the UK, Europe and specific areas of the APAC region – Australia and New Zealand.

Key focus and goal of this role is to collaborate with carefully selected partners in order to establish high quality; efficient; standardised and bespoke solutions; fulfilling the requirements of our customers and stakeholders. The post holder will also ensure that our technical and quality accreditations are compliant with industry and healthcare requirements.

The role extends to the responsibility for leading the company's efficiency drivers including reducing production costs, product development and innovation in key areas such as fleet development, fleet optimisation, fleet design and innovation. Engagement with our supply chain partners on a technical level is also a requirement to both ensure our statutory compliance and developing our sustainability credentials.

FLEXIBILITY

wider Europe which will require periods away from home. Occasional travel to support our Australian operations team may also be required.

The postholder will be required to attend meetings and customer sites outside of standard working hours as required and this reflects the nature of our healthcare customers.
